N J State WBA's 63rd Annual Tournament

Trenton Suburban will host the State Tournament this year. Team, doubles, and singles events will be held at Curtis Suburban Lanes in Trenton. The closing date is March 8, 2008. All entrants in this tournament must be NEW JERSEY CERTIFIED MEMBERS in good standing in their WBA and USBC. All others are ineligible.

The tournament dates are April 12, 13, 19, 20, 26, and 27, 2008. Squad times vary so try to get your applications in early. This will guarantee your preferred time. There are two divisions; those averaging 166 and over will compete in Division I while bowlers with a 165 and under will compete in Division II. A 90% handicap will be figured from the difference of actual individual averages and 220. Handicap for doubles and team events will be figured on combined individual averages. Entry fees are \$26.00 per bowler, per event. The "All Events" fee of \$3.00 for Division II and \$5.00 for Division I is optional.

Entry forms are available at all bowling centers throughout the State, or through your local Association Manager.
