Shirlee Kutzner Star of Tomorrow Award**

The Shirlee Kutzner Star of Tomorrow Award is an annual scholarship that honors a college-bound high school junior or senior young lady who is accomplished in the sport of bowling. The \$500 award was named for Shirlee Kutzner, a past NJSWBA President whose work on the youth level was very well recognized. It was established in 1990 making this the 20th anniversary of the honor.

It is with great pleasure that we present our 2010 recipient, Ms. Morgan Brown. Morgan received her award at the NJUSBCWBA Annual Meeting and Luncheon at the Fair Winds at Basking Ridge Country Club on May 16, 2010.

Morgan attends East Brunswick High School, in Middlesex County, NJ. She has been on the school's team for the last three years. While competing in the Greater Middlesex Conference, she was named to the All Conference, All Division, and the All Area team by Home News Tribune. In addition, the newspaper named her as the "Player of the Year".

Morgan averaged 225 for 77 games with a high game of 290 and high series of a 784. While bowling in the Bishop Ahr Holiday Classic, Morgan bowled the high game with a 278 and the high series of 694. She finished in 1st Place in the GMC Individual Tournament where she bowled a 290 game to defeat her opponent in the step-ladder final. While bowling in the Prodigal Tournament at Woodbridge Bowl, which raises money for children with cancer, Morgan was not only the top qualifier, she won the event which also had a step-ladder final. In the NJSIAA Individual finals, Morgan had the highest 6 game qualifying total and finished 2nd.

Morgan's coach says that she is a dedicated individual that works hard at her game. She practices multiple times a week and is truly a student of the sport of bowling.

The Central Jersey Middlesex County USBC also presented Morgan with an award and purchased a brick with her name engraved at the new USBC headquarters in Arlington, Texas in her honor. Congratulations to Morgan for all her accomplishments. Her family, East Brunswick High School, her youth association (Junior Gold Sport) and her friends have all contributed to her success and should be very proud to share this honor with their rising star.
