Format - One Day Competition

COMPETITION: All entrants will bowl on Sunday July 17, 2011 at **Majestic Lanes, 525 Route 9 North, Hopelawn, NJ 08861 (732) 826-6800**. All division entrants will bowl 6 games (3 games at Noon, 3 games at 2:00 pm). Medal ceremonies will be held after competition is completed.

DIVISIONS: SCHOLASTIC (through grade 12 including June graduates); YOUTH (Boys & Girls not over age 12 as of 06/01/11); SENIOR (55 Yrs. & Over as of 06/01/11); REGULAR (All NJ certified bowlers and those attending school in New Jersey, including those eligible for Scholastic, Youth and Senior divisions). IF LESS THAN THREE (3) ENTRANTS IN ANY SCHOLASTIC OR SENIOR DIVISION, ENTRANT WILL BE PLACED IN THE REGULAR DIVISION OF THE SAME AVERAGE. IF LESS THAN THREE (3) ENTRANTS IN THE YOUTH DIVISION, ENTRANT WILL BE PLACED IN THE SCHOLASTIC DIVISION OF THE SAME AVERAGE. IF LESS THAN THREE (3) ENTRANTS IN THE MALE DIVISION OF 155 AND HIGHER AVERAGE AND YOUTH IN THE FEMALE DIVISION OF 145 OR HIGHER AVERAGE, ENTRANT WILL BE PLACED IN THE SCHOLASTIC DIVISION.

- 319D - reporting of tournament prize winnings - waived

AWARDS: No cash awards. Medals will be awarded in each section of each division for first, second, and third places. In case of a tie for first place, both will receive a gold medal with no silver medal awarded. A tie for second, both will receive a silver medal with no bronze medal awarded. A tie for third, both will receive a bronze medal.

COMPETITION FORMAT: Entrants bowl 6 games in two 3-game blocks Sunday July 17, 2011. Total pin fall counts (no handicap) to determine medal winners. To be eligible for medals, bowlers must compete in all six (6) games.

DRESS CODE: No short shorts or bathing suits will be allowed. Appropriate bowling attire must be worn.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1). Be sure to carefully read all of the Sport Information in this application. Fill out the application form completely and make sure your event codes are correct on your application.
- 2). In the Sport Information Section, list USBC League Average, league and center where 2009 - 2010 average for 21 games or more was attained. If no 2009 - 2010 average, bowlers may use their 2010 summer average for 21 games or more. If no 2009-2010 average or 2010 summer average, bowlers may use the 2010-2011-season average for 21 games or more, or a current average of 21 games or more as of July 1st. Also list your USBC 2010-2011-membership number. Entrants must show membership card when checking in. Non-members may bowl in any event by purchasing an associate membership card (USBC Adults \$21.00 or USBC Youth \$17.00) or pay a USBC Tournament participation fee of \$5.00 or Adults or \$2.00 for Youth & Scholastic Divisions. These additional fees can be made at check-in on July 17, 2011. All certified bowlers are eligible and may enter only one division. Bowlers lacking a certified verifiable average must enter the highest division in their class. Females must bowl in female divisions.
- 3). Read and sign the waiver that is located on the bottom portion of the application. Applications without a signed waiver will be returned.
- 4). Incomplete applications will be returned and may delay or prevent participation. APPLICATION AND FEES WILL BE RETAINED BY THE GARDEN STATE GAMES. Please make sure the application is complete and correct.
- 5). Include a check or money order payable to the NJ STATE BOWLING COUNCIL. CASH PAYMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS UNLESS ENTRY IS NOT ACCEPTED BY THE GARDEN STATE GAMES AND/OR BOWLING COUNCIL.
